SUBJECT: USF Police to Conduct Comprehensive
Roadside Safety Checkpoint

TAMPA: The University of South Florida Police Department will host a one-hour Comprehensive Roadside Safety Checkpoint on the USF Campus on October 14, 2014, beginning at 8:00 p.m. The checkpoint operation will be immediately followed by a 7-hour saturation patrol.
