The new department will be home to USF's growing biomedical engineering program

The success of the USF biomedical engineering (BME) graduate program, which has grown more than 50 percent over the last five years and is currently the largest BME graduate program in Florida, will lead to the launch of a bachelor's program in biomedical engineering at USF in the near future.

Robert Frisina, PhD, director of the Biomedical Engineering Program, will serve as interim chair of the Medical Engineering Department. An advisory group of National Academy members is being formed to help attract world class faculty to the new program.
