- x The first GC cohort of 23 students (from 2011) will be traveling abroad this summer.
- x The 2012 cohorts (from Business, Honors, Engineering, and CAS) are progressing well.
- x There will potentially be 100 more GC students added next year (2013), possibly from the COPH, CoEDU, The Arts, and CAS.
- x The Global Citizenship Living Learning Community (GC LLC) is currently being formed for the 2013-2014 academic year. There are 56 ptaceserved in Holly G for GC LLC students. They will be a combination of returning GC students, and newbyuited, FTIC GC students.
